Registration and Fees

Registration and entry fees must be received no later than Monday, Jan. 18, 2010 to avoid a late fee. Entry fee is \$50 per boat, Late Entry \$70 Registration includes a regatta hat, a light breakfast Saturday and Sunday, lunch on the water on Saturday and a Bar-B-Q lunch after racing on Sunday. On-site registrations will receive the late fee. Entries can be completed by filling out the [online registration form](#).

Official Regatta Details

1. This regatta is classified as a Category A event and will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing except as changed by the Sailing Instructions or any appendices to the Sailing Instructions.
2. Scoring- The Low Point System will apply except that if 5 or more races are completed, the worst eligible score will be discarded. One race shall constitute a regatta. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boats series score shall be the sum of her race scores. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.
3. Sailing Instructions-Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in
4. Courses-All races will be sailed in Buttonwood Sound. Courses will be specified in the Sailing Instructions
5. Safety-All competitors shall wear U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets at all times while on the water. Failure to do may be protested by the Race Committee and could result in disqualification.
6. Disclaimers of Liability- Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta. Each competitor must fill out and have signed by a parent a waiver of liability and medical form.
